You are eligible to enroll in Allwell Medicare Simple (HMO) if:

- You are entitled to Medicare Part A and enrolled in Medicare Part B. Members must continue to pay their Medicare Part B premium if not otherwise paid for under Medicaid or by another third party.
- You must be a United States citizen, or are lawfully present in the United States and permanently reside in the service area of the plan (in other words, your permanent residence is within the Allwell Medicare Simple (HMO) service area counties).
